Terms and Conditions

- The golf buggy should always be driven carefully and responsibly. It is prohibited to drive
 across tees and greens, and no aggressive braking should be carried out on the fairways.
 The parking brake should always be applied when the buggy is left unattended.
- Marshall Leisure will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage, which may occur when using the golf buggies.
- No alcohol is to be consumed while hiring or using the golf buggies.
- The hirer must have a comprehensive insurance policy that covers all losses, injuries or damage which may be sustained by you or a third party as a result of any accidents.
- The hirer must notify a Marshall Leisure member of staff of any damage or if the buggy is not in an acceptable condition prior to use.
- The hirer accepts that they will be liable for any damage incurred during the hire and the cost of the damage will be charged by Marshall Leisure to the hirer.
- The hirer accepts that any mis-use or irresponsible behaviour with a buggy may result in being immediately removed from the course or banned from playing the course again. This is exercised at the management team's discretion.
- The hirer accepts these conditions by purchasing a hire of a golf buggy from Marshall Leisure. Reference to these terms and conditions is detailed on the till receipt.
